Yesterday afternoon, the Prime Minister announced that New Zealand will move into Alert Level 2 from 11.59pm on Wednesday 13 May

Schools will start again on Monday 18 May.

A few students started back at level 3 and they can continue to attend school. The students who are returning for the first time this Term can start back on **Monday 18 May**.
