Alert Level 2 Guidelines:

Entering the School

- Students may enter the school from **8.30 am**
- The back gate (Tyrone Street) will be open for an hour from **8.30 am to 9.30 am**. It will then be locked until **2.30 pm**. The back gate is only for students' use.
- Hand sanitiser will be available at the entrance of all classrooms.
- **Parents** – can farewell students at the front or back gate.
- **Parents** – if you wish to speak to someone at the office, please (a) report to the office first (b) hand sanitise (c) provide contact details.





Exiting the School

- School finishes at 3.00 pm
- Children can exit through the **front gate** (Pearl Baker Drive) or the **back gate** (Tyrone Street).
- Parents may pick up their child/ren at the gate
- Parents – may choose to enter the school.

They must (a) report to the office first (b) hand sanitise (c) provide contact details

Classroom Guidelines

- Teachers will share/teach hygiene procedures at the beginning of each day.
- Students will wash their hands prior to eating time and sanitise before going out to play.
- Students will sanitise hands when returning from breaks.
- Eating times: students must be seated within their classroom. Food scraps and litter will be collected by appointed monitors. Lunchboxes must be returned to school bags and school bags properly closed.



NOTE: All children will need to bring a drink bottle as the drinking fountains will not be available.

Sharing Space Guidelines

- Mayfield playgrounds are open.
- The field may be closed during wet weather. (Signage will indicate field closure).
- Hygiene procedures will be followed when going out and returning from breaks.
- Adventure playgrounds (StarQuest and AusPlay) are open.
- A support staff member will supervise each of these areas. They are not on general duty).
- While no strict social distancing is required when outside, the teacher on duty may intervene where hygiene is compromised.

If a student becomes ill while they are at school, parents/whānau will be contacted so that the child can be taken home immediately.
