

School Re-opens

We extend a warm welcome to all Mayfield students who start back on Monday 31 August. The school is well prepared for Alert Level 2 and we are putting into action the Safety Plan.

Safe hygiene practice will be required by all. Children will be reminded of the expectations and new healthy habits taught as part of the learning.



Wash your hands with soap and water often (for at least 20 seconds). Then dry.



Cough or sneeze into your elbow or by covering your mouth and nose with tissues.



Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces and objects, such as doorknobs.



Don't touch your eyes, nose or mouth if your hands are not clean.



Put used tissues in the bin or a bag immediately.



Stay home if you feel unwell.

Visiting the School

All parents/visitors are required to come to the office (front door) of the office. They will be asked a few questions for contact tracing. To avoid overcrowding, we ask parents to come up only if it is really necessary.

Back Gate

The back gate will be open between 8.30 am and 9.30am. In the afternoon, the gate will be open from 2.30 pm to 3.30 pm

Parents/visitors/ students are asked to use the front gate (Pearl Baker Drive) for important matters.

For health reasons, the water fountains are not going to be operating at school. Children are required to bring their own water bottles. They can refill the bottles from taps inside the classroom.
