Mana Kidz is a school-based health programme providing health and well-being services to the children of Mayfield School.

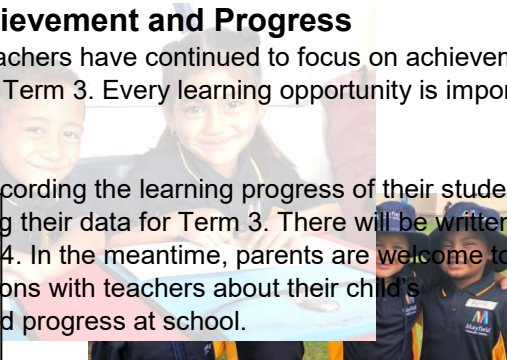
It is pleasing to see that 100% of the students are enrolled on the programme. The nurses and health service workers are from Southsea Healthcare.

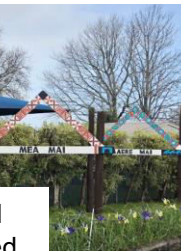


Kia Orana Mayfield parents,
