Looking forward to seeing you at our next whole school celebrations on Tuesday 30th June – for Matariki and our Whole school assembly at 1.00pm at our canopy.

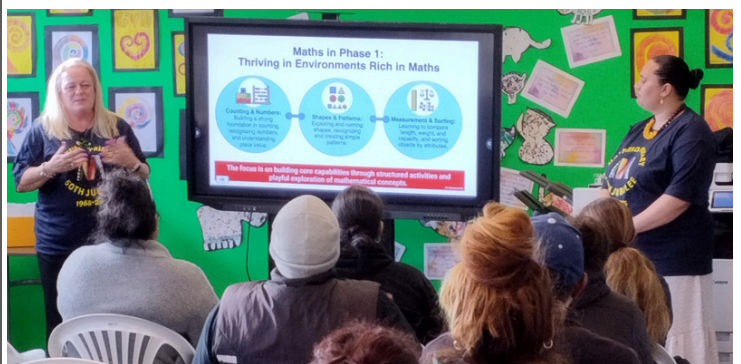
